Greetings Barnyard Buzzards,

Deciding on topics to talk about has its pitfalls. There are so many things that our hobby demands for a safe environment.

Last month, I wrote about communicating your intentions on the field and how other members on the flight line should respond so that the pilot knows that he has been heard. During our "Freeze-In" event, I was involved in a near miss (hit?).

This caused me to think that it might be a good idea to touch base on this subject a little further.

I was flying in the area in front of me over the runway. Another flyer had called out that he was landing. I did not hear him because at the same time as him calling out, a vehicle was leaving. The noise from the vehicle muted out his voice. I'm pleased to say that it turned out okay as both of us saw the imminent crash and avoided it. If you hear someone call out and notice another flyer not paying attention to that call out or not replying, please add your voice to help ensure a safe flying experience. Some of our pilots do have some hearing impairment so a

little help would be great. Safe flying involves everyone being aware of what others are doing. Not just what you are doing. Let's work together to keep accidents and injuries from happening.

I am not aware of any injuries or aircraft mishaps. If you experience or wit-

ness a mishap or, worse, an injury, please reach out to me at my number posted in this newsletter.

We are developing a 1/10 scale crawler area for those days when the wind makes it hard to fly.








Barnyard Buzzards - Buzzard Droppings - February

25600 Monroe Camp Road, Snohomish, WA

Camp Edward and the Hanner's Memorial Field are located north of Monroe, Washington in Snohomish County. The most common route is from Highway 2 in Monroe near Albertson's. Turn north onto Woods Creek Road. As you travel north on Woods Creek Road, it will come to a Y intersection, stay to the right (Yeager Rd).



Yeager will rejoin Woods Creek Road at a 4-way intersection. Stay straight-ish, not a hard right, <u>be careful as oncoming traffic does not stop</u>. In a few miles you will pass the entrance to Camp Pigott. Keep going. Turn right at the "T" intersection at Lake Roesiger Road. At the next "Y" intersection, stay right, staying on South Lake Roesiger Road. Turn right at Monroe Camp Road, (Lake Roesiger Store will be on the left). In about a mile, the road will fork again, stay straight. After a short distance you will see our club sign and our gate. Our parking is past the gate on the right. It seems complicated, but once you come out, you'll see it is an easy drive....

Our next club meeting is Tuesday, February13th at 6:30 PM at the Alfy's Pizza in Monroe, WA




